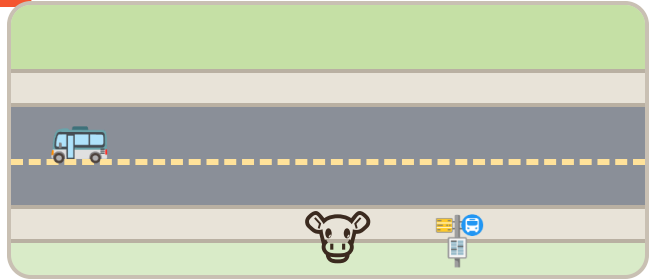

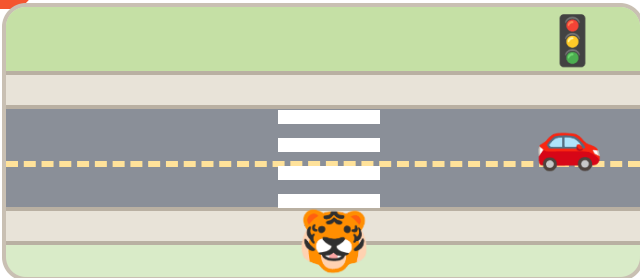

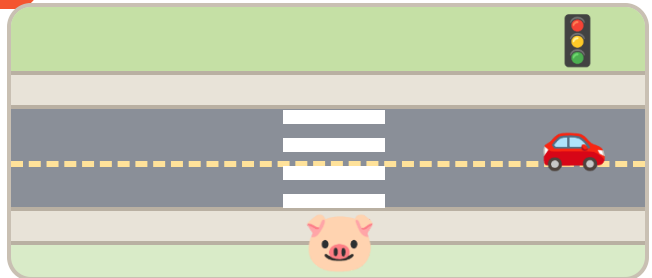

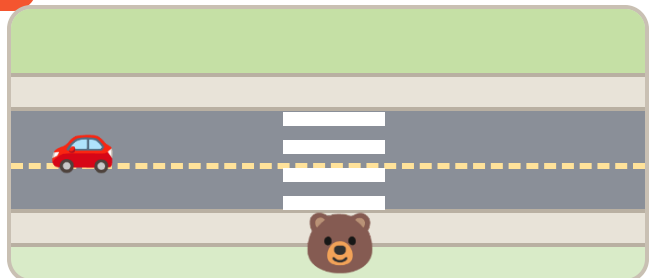

Answer key

Page 1: Look left, right, left again

1. Steps in order: **1** Stop at the curb, **2** Look left, **3** Look right, **4** Look left again, **5** Walk, don't run (card order on the sheet: 5, 4, 1, 3, 2)
2. Arrows: **left**, **right**, **left again**
3. Walking person: **look first, then walk**. Flashing hand: **do not start crossing**.

Page 2: Circle the safe choice

1. **In the park or yard** (not: In the parking lot)
2. **On the sidewalk, back from the road** (not: In the road)
3. **Stop and wait** (not: Cross quickly)
4. **Wait for the car to pass** (not: Wave and go)
5. **On the path with a grown-up** (not: In the middle of the road)

6. **At the crosswalk** (not: Between parked cars)

Page 3: Gear up - Call 9-1-1?

1. **Helmet** → **1** going for a bike ride (keeps your head safe on a bike, scooter or skates)
2. **Seatbelt** → **2** riding in the car (keeps you in your seat if the car stops fast)
3. **Life jacket** → **3** playing on the dock or a boat (keeps you floating near water)
4. Call 9-1-1: **C, D, E, F**
5. Not an emergency: **A, B, G, H**

Page 4: My safety card

Filled in by the child with a grown-up. Check the phone number is a real number for the child's grown-up, and have the child say their full name and their grown-up's full name out loud.
